Tom Gosnell is senior vice president and president, Commercial Vehicle Systems (CVS) for ArvinMeritor, Inc., a \$7-billion, premier global automotive supplier of a broad range of integrated systems, modules and components for light vehicle, commercial truck, trailer and specialty original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) and related aftermarkets. Gosnell also has responsibility for the direction of the company's global commercial vehicle aftermarket sales and service business. His extensive aftermarket experience and deep understanding of the importance of leveraging a global distribution network help support ArvinMeritor's strategy to capture new market opportunities. Before the July 2000 merger of Arvin, Inc. and Meritor Automotive, Inc., Gosnell was president of CVS Aftermarket and senior vice president of Meritor, a global supplier of components and systems for commercial, specialty and light vehicle OEMs and the aftermarket.



Gosnell joined Rockwell/Meritor in 1979 as purchasing manager for the company's former Winchester, Ky., plant. Before taking leadership of Meritor's Aftermarket business, he held several management positions of increasing responsibility, including tenure as value analysis manager for the on-highway manufacturing department, materials manager at Meritor's Winchester facility, and plant manager in Florence, Ky.
